### 5/ Zurich Airport, Switzerland (average rating 4.3)

Zurich Airport is ranked fifth best airport in Europe, with 26,317 positive reviews. What makes the Swiss airport stand out? It boasts a 250-meter-long observation deck that offers a spectacular 360-degree view. The "Airside Center" houses over 80 shops, including the largest selection of Swiss chocolate at any airport worldwide. The SBB train station under the airport also provides connections to Zurich Central Station every 10 minutes. The airport is committed to sustainability, aiming to become climate-neutral by 2050.

### 4/ Prague Airport, Czech Republic (average rating 4.3)

Prague Airport, officially Vaclav Havel Airport, is ranked as the fourth-best airport in Europe, with 26,441 reviews.
