

TOP 10 GAYEST CITIES IN EUROPE



Gaining acceptance in society as a homosexual individual can be challenging. However, a Pew Research Center survey found that 7% of adults identify as lesbian, gay, or bisexual. Additionally, a Gallup survey in 2022 indicated that LGBT identification in the U.S. was 7.1%, up from 5.6% in 2020. 10/ Oslo, Norway
